TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS OVERVIEW

1. Volleyball Victoria will provide a Chief Referee who will determine the outcomes of any disputes as they arise.
2. All Honours matches will be best of five sets, with all other Divisions running under a best of three set formats, except Finals which will be best of five sets. The finals format will be decided once final entries are known.
3. Points awarded in games will be 3 – win, 1 – loss and 0 – forfeit.
4. The penalty for failing to fulfil duty obligations for any single game will be a loss of 1 point.
5. All teams must fulfil duty obligations. Honours teams will be supplied with a first referee for each match, but will need to supply a second referee, scorer and two line judges. All other Divisions must provide a 1st and 2nd Referee plus scorer and two line judges. In the Honours Grand Finals, all referees will be provided.
6. The scheduled commencement time for the last game on each day will be determined by the number of entries received.
7. Six players must take to the Court in all games played. Exemption may be granted if players are lost through serious injuries.
8. All players in the Men's and Women's Honours Division teams will be required to play in uniform attire i.e. the same colour shirts and shorts, and each player shall have a number on the front and back of their playing shirts. This requirement will be relaxed slightly for Division 1 and 2 teams but all are expected to play in the same coloured shirts and shorts which shall be numbered.
9. The Tournament will be conducted under the control of the Tournament Committee.
10. Molten will be the balls used for this Tournament, being the official VVI ball provider.
11. Entry fees must accompany all entries received.
12. In the event of excessively hot weather, technical time outs will be permitted to allow player hydration. The implementation of these time outs will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
